Uncle Foster's Hat Tree, by Doug Cushman - Merle (a mouse) is at his uncle's house, He is bored... until he finds Uncle Foster's hat tree. It is full of funny hats. Better yet, there is a story to go with each one.

Building Christian Character, by Michael Waite - A series of books on topics including overcoming jealousy, sharing, being thankful/helpful, kindness, and obedience.

New Boots for Spring - A Book of Seasons, by Harriet Ziefert and Deborah Ray - (ages 2-5) Great pictures! Children will enjoy recognizing the ever-changing seasons.
